


Our Mission

About Us

Chalk It Up aims to empower and support the next generation of Sacramento artists through targeted art grants for young artists and the programs which inspire them. Our free Labor Day Weekend Chalk It Up! Festival at Fremont Park is our biggest event of the year, bringing people from all over the Sacramento region downtown to celebrate chalk art and music, and to help us fund the work that we do throughout the rest of the year.





History

Chalk It Up began as a handful of artists, creating chalk art in different locations throughout Sacramento. In 1991, these artists decided to combine their efforts and they organized the first annual Chalk Art festival in Fremont Park. The festival has grown from its early days, and now features hundreds of chalk artists, dozens of food and craft vendors, over 30 musical acts and nearly 60,000 attendees annually. As Chalk It Up has grown, so has our vision of supporting and uplifting youth arts in the Sacramento region.
